

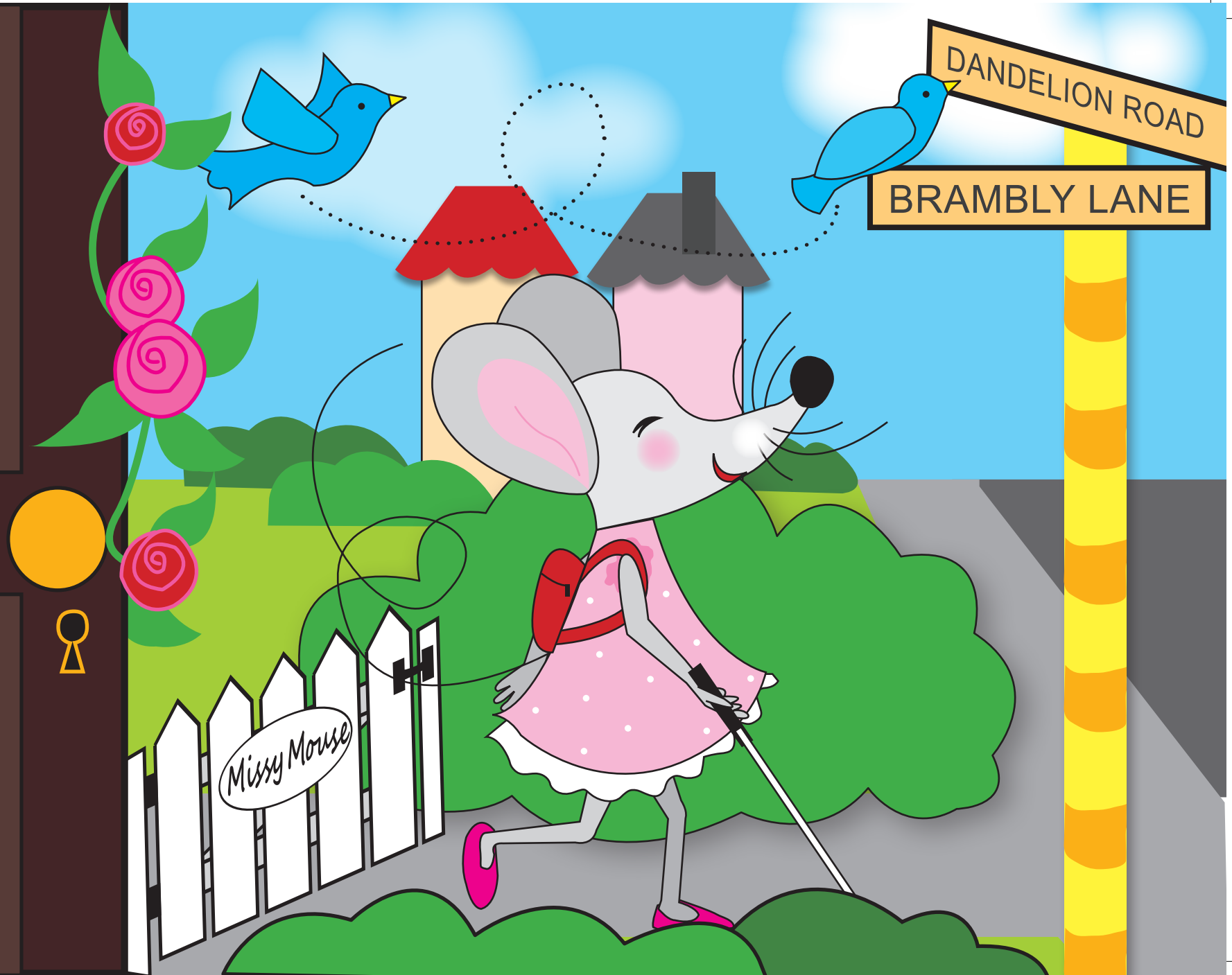

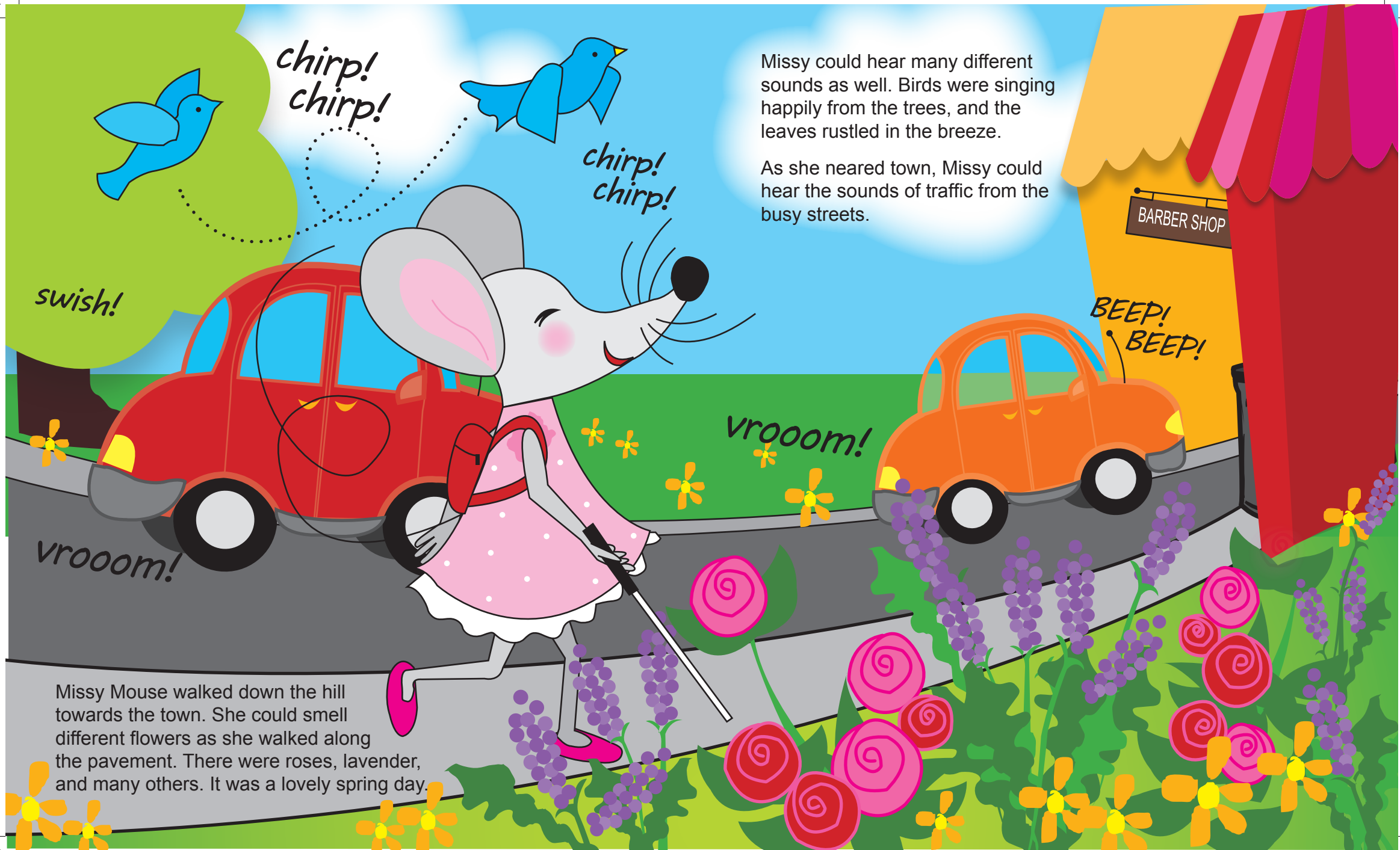
“Good morning, sun.
